INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION AND DIRECTION

DELEGATION

Pursuant to section 406 of the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW) (Uniform Law) and section 28(2) of the Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014 (NSW) (Application Act) I hereby delegate to the Bar Council (as defined in the Application Act):

- 1. My functions under Chapter 5 of the *Uniform Law*;
- 2. My functions under Chapter 7 of the *Uniform Law* and other provisions of the *Uniform Law* relating to Chapter 5;
- 3. My functions under the Legal Profession Uniform General Rules (NSW) relating to Chapter 5;
- 4. My functions under sections 137 and 144 of the Application Act

except for the following functions:

- A. *Uniform Law* section 313 conduct of an internal review of a decision made by me or my delegate;
- B. *Uniform Law* section 406 delegation of my functions;
- C. Uniform Law section 411 taking over responsibility for a matter from a delegate.

DIRECTION

I further issue a direction under section 408 of the *Uniform Law* that the Bar Council may exercise the functions delegated to it only in circumstances where I have referred a complaint to it to deal with in accordance with legal profession legislation (as defined in the *Application Act*). The following functions are excluded from this Direction:

- A. *Uniform Law* section 282(2) and (3) appointment of person to conduct a complaints investigation
- B. Uniform Law section 436 entering into arrangements with authorities

Note: Nothing in this Instrument of Delegation and Direction derogates from my functions under Chapter 5 of the *Uniform Law* in respect of any complaint which is not referred to the Council.
